The annual meeting committees invite proposals for the 2010 joint annual meeting in York, Pennsylvania on November 5-6, 2010. The meeting will be held at the historic Yorktowne Hotel in downtown York, PA. Papers on all geographic topics are accepted. Workshops, organized paper sessions, thematic discussion panels and posters are also being accepted for the meeting. We are pleased to be once again hosting the PASSHE GIS Consortium on Friday afternoon and PAGE will be holding K-12 education workshops on Saturday morning. Paper presentations are limited to 15 minutes; abstracts of a maximum of 150 words should be submitted with registration. Meeting registration will begin on September 1st. **We strongly encourage you to submit your abstracts and registration on-line at our web site: www.thepgs.org.** If you do send your abstract via the mail, please enclose it on a CD. ****Paper submissions are accepted until October 15th!****



Undergraduate and graduate papers are welcome and are eligible to compete for the Elaine Bosowski Award. Students can also submit a map or an electronic (computer/web-based) map for consideration in the annual Student Map Contest. More details about the student competitions can be found on the PGS website. On Saturday morning MAD student teams will compete in the Geography Bowl.

The Friday Luncheon will be held in the Yorktowne Hotel's Mirror Room. MAD has arranged guest speaker John Page Williams, Senior Naturalist with the Chesapeake Bay Foundation and author of the book "Chesapeake: Exploring the Water Trail of Captain John Smith." The Friday night banquet will be held at the Agricultural and Industrial Museum run by the York County Heritage Trust. The museum is an easy walk from the hotel and all of the museum's exhibits will be open for banquet guests to tour. A cash bar will also be provided. This year's banquet speaker is the 2010 PGS Distinguished Geographer Award winner Dr. Janet Smith from Shippensburg University. Jan is currently the Coordinator for the Pennsylvania Alliance for Geographic Education and was the 2008 President of the National Council for Geographic Education. On Saturday afternoon, David Fyfe of York College will be giving a walking tour of historic downtown York.
